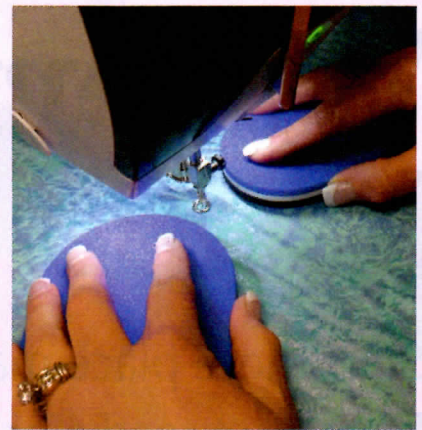


## T-Shirts, Memories & More

## Grip & Stitch Quilting Disks

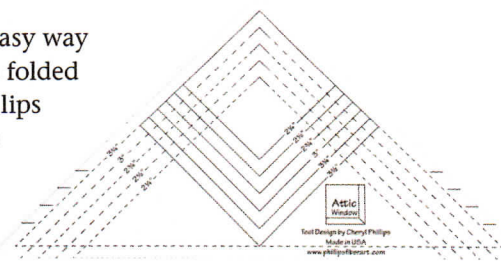

## Attic Window Tool

Make Attic Window blocks the easy way without "Y" seams by using the fun folded technique by Cheryl Phillips of Phillips Fiber Art where innovative tools are made for you, the creative quilter. This triangle-shaped template allows you to fussy-cut the exact window needed using the square boxes given in six different sizes from 2¼"–3½". Just cut, fold and sew, and your Attic Window will come to life when the center triangle pops up, opens and lies flat as a square. Leave the window as is for a great 3-D look or stitch along the edges of the square if preferred.

All of the baby shapes are compatible with each other. The same is true with the small shapes, the medium shapes and the large shapes, making design possibilities endless.
